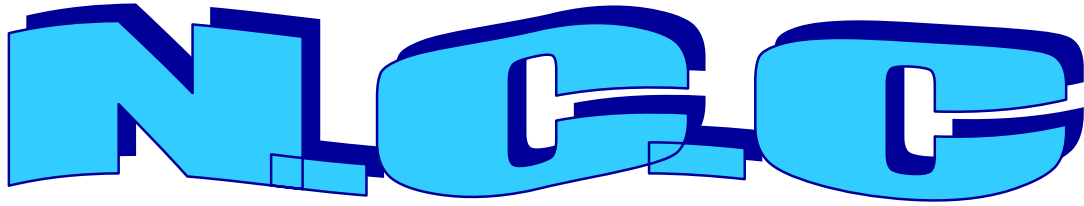

With a view to inculcating virtues such as unity and discipline, our college conducts various activities under the auspices of National Cadet Corps (N.C.C). The students are admitted to N.C.C keeping in view their height, weight, physical fitness and punctuality.

During the academic year 2008-2009 36 boys and 05 girls were selected from First B.A, 37 boys from second B. A and 23 boys from Third B.A were selected. Thus the NCC unit of our college consists of 101 cadets.

All the cadets have to attend five hours for parade, knowing armaments , war-skill, map-reading and social services.

From time to time, camps of national level such as (ATC) trekking, Republic Day Camp (RDC) TSC etc are organized. All the cadets of our college take part in all these camps. Sixty students of our college took part in ATC camp held at Kadi. In this camp rifle-shooting, parade, Volleyball, running competition etc. were held, in which, the senior under officer of our NCC unit Chaudhary Manoj A. won gold medal in Rifle shooting competition. He also defined his stand for Infrantry soldier's training. Five cadets of our unit took part in Vollyball and they had been **Runners Up** and won **Five Silver Medals**.

Raval Mukesh H. won **Gold Medal** in Advanced Shooting inter group competition in (ATC) camp held in Ahmedabad. He also won **Silver Medal** in Map reading. Momin Ahsan Ali won **Gold Medal** in all wing shooting, and

Bronze Medal in rifle shooting. He was also selected for **Infrontary Soldier Camp**.

All India **Thal Sainik Camp** was held in Delhi in which all the states of India took part. A special team of Gujarat was formed in which 7000 cadets from Gujarat took part in it. 22 cadets were selected for one month's training for ' **Thal Sainik camp**', three cadets of our college were selected in which Chaudhary Manoj, Raval Mukesh and Momin Ahsan Ali took part in 'Thal Sainik Camp', Delhi. Thus our cadets have earned credit for Gujarat in Delhi at the same time they illumined the name of our college.
