Prof. L. M. Revadiwala also retired as Head of Department on 31-10-2008. Hence Prof. K. T. Deria had to render his duty as an I/c Principal as well as Head of English Department. Prof. K. T. Deria is sincere and committed teacher whose special areas are literary criticism and linguistics. His book **“Geoffery Chaucer : A Critical Spectrum”** was published in 2007 by Mark Publisher, Jaipur. He has presented various papers on literary topics viz.

# College Library

Our college library has been rich and is being enriched with many new books of various branches of learning. During the current academic year i.e 2009-2010, 1600 students became the members of the library. Besides the students and teachers of the college, the students of M. Phil and Ph.D. also reap advantage of our college with a view to being helpful to the research scholars, the library extends its advantage to them accepting deposits from them.

In this age of knowledge and information explosion, the college library is being modernized. Up to this year total 33114 books data entries have been already made in the sole software. The process of bar-coding and classification of the books is going on at present, which is expected to be over the next year.

In order to increase reading habit among the students, the college library organizes various programmes. During 2008-2009 such two programmes were held in which the students were shown C.D of the book ‘ **Prerananu Zaranu**’ written by Jitendra Adhiya. A small exhibition entitled ‘ **Let us Know Geography**’ was held in which various books, charts and maps of Geography were exhibited. During the year 2009-2010, under the auspices of ‘ **Nature Club**’ an exhibition on environment was held on 15-9-2009. Many students took part in it with great zeal and expressed their own views on the exhibition. Another exhibition of 288 books was held in which helped enhancing students’ interest in reading books.
